Foyer Maillard continues to be adhering to our Single Site Order as it relates to staffing and this seems to be working well thus far. We also continue to re-evaluate the past 3 months in an effort to prepare for the possibility of a second wave later this year. We have a sufficient amount of PPE at this time. Staff are continuing to support virtual visits and phone calls so as to assist residents to stay in touch.

On June 7 we proudly celebrated the fourth anniversary of our new building and the 51st anniversary of our society/charity. Throughout the last 51 years the Societe du Foyer Maillard has delivered supportive services and housing to older adults. In fact we have cared for or housed over 1700 adults since opening in 1969.
